ADD VALUE BUILDING GROUP

Its been another big year for Add Value Building Group. After making the decision to move from just renovations and commercial fit outs, to focus primarily on offering their residential clients the best service in Renovations, New Custom Homes and Transportable Homes, it has been incredibly rewarding and busy for the team! With their building knowledge and expertise second to none, they have definitely had their fair share of complex builds and renovations throughout the past year due to a spike in residential development.

When speaking with Ciaran Mullin, Managing Director, about how they have refocused throughout the spike in residential development and COVID-19, he said "We have always been busy. During this period my biggest challenge is keeping an eye on material supply chains and costs. Doing the right thing for all involved is important to me – I like my projects to be a win win for everyone involved, including suppliers, workers, the client and my business."

With a new two-storey timber framed home commencing in Bayswater at the moment, amongst an impressive project portfolio that keeps growing, we all can't wait to see what Add Value Building Group produce next!!

PROJECT HIGHLIGHT - TOM PRICE MODULAR HOMES

This was an 11 home multi-unit project for Add Value, that they started and will have delivered the homes within 12 months. This development was originally a 20 unit build which were originally designed with the intention of an on site build, not a transportable build. Due to a current shortage of accommodation, and higher build costs in Tom Price, Add Value had to come up with a way to build these homes as a transportable, while making zero changes to the external look of the homes to avoid having to submit for a new development approval, which has successfully been done and delivered!

Each home is built on three concrete slabs with steel frame walls, steel truss roof, all external walls and ceilings insulated, cladded in Hardie [™] Fine Texture Cladding and all with a colour-bond roof. Each home then gets split into three, and sent up on trucks for a 16 hour trip to Tom Price and set into their on site position exactly as they were built in the Add Value yard in Neerabup.
