JDS Concealed metal doorframe profile is designed to achieve a contemporary seamless finish. The design allows for no architraves and compliments a clean, modern aesthetic.



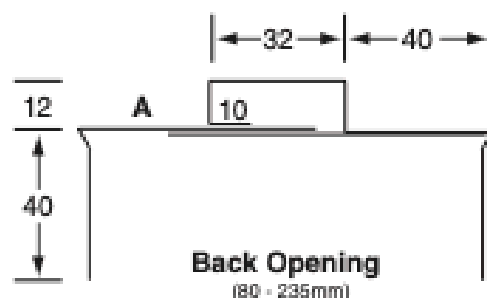
Technical Specifications

JDS Concealed metal doorframe is made from 1.05mm Zincaneal. The frames come in 6 separate pieces that are strapped together for transport. The frame is fixed through the perforated architrave and then plastered over for a seamless finish.

Prior to installing the frame ensure stud opening sizes are suitable for Concealed frames.

For stud opening sizes add 33mm to your door HEIGHT and 25mm to your door WIDTH*

Example: Door size 2040 x 820mm, Stud opening 2073 x 845

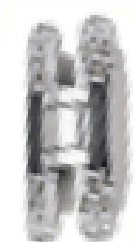

Please note - Concealed frames are NOT supplied with hinges

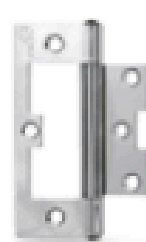
- **Hirline hinges are fixed after installation (can be supplied by JDS upon request)**
- **Concealed hinges can also be supplied upon request. This will require frame modification and hinges to be supplied by JDS.**

***If you are using Concealed hinges, your stud opening width will be your door width plus 40mm.**

PRODUCT RETURNS

JBS realises that mistakes are part of our industry & when it is ours we rectify in the most timely efficient way we can to minimise any impact on the customer.

Where a customer has made the error we will assist as best we can, but we are bound by some considerations.

- If the product is made to order or a non-stocked item it is up to the discretion of the manufacturer if these goods can be returned. Any costs enforced by the manufacturer will be passed to the customer in full.
- Product being returned must be in a resalable condition (as determined by JBS and/or the manufacturer)
- **Highlighting metal door frames, these must be “clean” (not have any mortar residue) & must also have the spreader bars still attached.**
- There are costs involved in the return of goods & whilst we keep these to a minimum they will be applied at all times.
